GUIDANCE FOR NEW MEMBERS

Before flying it is a requirement of club membership and site usage that BMFA insurance is obtained. Mersey Flyers can arrange this for you.

New and inexperienced flyers should seek advice as regards to the airworthiness of their aircraft prior to flight.

New members will be given a copy of the club rules and constitution which they should make themselves familiar with prior to operating any aircraft.

The club operates a peg board system for 35 MHz users. Before switching on any 35MHz transmitter the appropriate peg must be obtained.

When using the flying site, vehicles are permitted to drive onto the flight line for the purposes of unloading, however, in the interests of safety vehicles must be removed immediately after and parked in the designated area.

Children who are not members are allowed in the pits area but again, for safety reasons, must be accompanied and supervised by an adult at all times.

It is strongly recommended that no pets are brought into the pits or runways.

When leaving the club site unoccupied it is the responsibility of the individual member to ensure that the gate is locked.
